Lethal Weapon 4 – 35 Sea Stags – 34

In what has to be the game of the year so far in the UFFL, Lethal Weapon 4 took a 27-22 lead after the early Sunday games and held on by their fingertips to score a huge one point victory and claim the THMBSCL Division championship and clinch the Number One seed for the UFFL playoffs.

QB Peyton Manning and **RB** Domanick Davis each had 12 points to carry the load for LW4, while **SS** leading scorer Priest Holmes ran in his 16th and 17th TD's of the season to lead their effort.
