Outlaws – 77 Sea Stags – 38

For the second week in a row, Sea Stags lose the Mel Grey game in spectacular fashion. Unlike last week, however, this one was not significant for its drama and close score. This was an ass-whipping of historic proportion laid down by Outlaws, who scored a UFFL-record 77 points behind a UFFL-record 42 individual points from Clinton Portis, that included five TD runs, two of which were +50 yards. Outlaws also got 24 points from QB Jeff Garcia, who had four TD passes and two TD runs.
